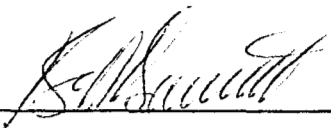
BY-LAW NUMBER 1978-6

A by-law to designate certain property  
as property of historic and architectural  
value and interest (Merrick Thomas House)

THE COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The property commonly known and referred to as the Merrick Thomas House is hereby designated as a property of historic and architectural value and interest pursuant to The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.
2. The property designated by this by-law is the property described in Schedule "A" to this by-law.
3. The designation affects only as much of the lot as is covered by the Merrick Thomas House.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land situate,  
lying and being in the Town of Oakville, in the Regional  
Municipality of Halton and being composed of Lot B, Block 77  
according to the original plan for the Town of Oakville (now  
commonly referred to as Plan 1) registered in the Land Registry  
Office for the Land Registry Division of Halton.
