

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 1998-19

A by-law to repeal part of by-law 1980-70 as to certain lands and to reaffirm as to certain lands

WHEREAS By-law 1980-70 was passed on May 5, 1980 designating the property known municipally as 85 Navy Street of historical and architectural value and interest pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Oakville intends to redevelop part of the property at 85 Navy Street into a municipal parking lot;

AND WHEREAS a new survey of the designated property (20R-12619) was completed on December 10, 1997, and deposited by the Deputy Land Registrar for the Land Titles Division of Halton (No. 20) on December 19, 1997.

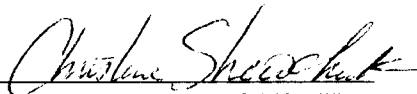
THE COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 1980-70 is hereby repealed as to the lands described as Firstly and Secondly in Schedule "A" to this By-law.
2. That By-law 1980-70 is hereby confirmed as to the lands described as Thirdly in Schedule "A" to this By-law.
3. Schedule "A" forms part of this by-law.

SCHEDULE "A"

FIRSTLY: Part of Lot D, Block 9, Plan 1, Town of Oakville, Regional Municipality of Halton, designated as Parts 3 and 4 on Plan 20R-12619.

SECONDLY: Part of Lots D and E, Block 9, Plan 1, Town of Oakville, Regional Municipality of Halton, designated as Part 5 on Plan 20R-12619.

THIRDLY: Part of Lot D, Block 9, Registered Plan 1, Town of Oakville, Regional Municipality of Halton, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 20R-12619.
